ALASKA POSITIVE 2010 is the statewide juried photographic exhibition organized and toured by the Alaska State Museum. Its purpose is to encourage the practice of photography as an art form in Alaska. The exhibition will open in Juneau and travel throughout Alaska concluding a statewide tour in 2011. The Alaska State Museum wishes to thank The Friends of the Alaska State Museum for its continued support of Alaska Positive and for sponsoring this year's Juror's Choice and Recognition Awards.

JUROR

RICHARD ROSS has been teaching at the University of California at Santa Barbara since 1977. Ross has an extensive exhibition record in the United States and Europe. He has photographed for the New York Times Magazine, Los Angeles Times Magazine, Discover, Time, Newsweek, Vogue, San Francisco Examiner, Frankfurter Allgemeine, and other noteworthy publications. Ross was the principal photographer for the J. Paul Getty Museum during their Villa restoration project, and is currently the principal photographer for the Getty Conservation Institute (GCI). With this title, he is documenting the research work of the GCI in El Salvador, Honduras, Tunisia, and China. His most recent exhibition at ACME in Los Angeles was named one of the 10 best exhibitions of 2007 by Tom Vanderbilt in ARTFORUM. His book, entitled Architecture of Authority, was named one of the best books of 2007 by PDN magazine. Ross is the recent recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship and has been the recipient of NEA and Fulbright Fellowships in previous years.

CALENDAR

APRIL 2, 2010 - ALL MAILED AND HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES ARE DUE. Deadline for receipt is 3:30 p.m., at the Alaska State Museum in Juneau.

April 8, 2010 - Lecture by the juror, Richard Ross, at 7:00 p.m. at the Alaska State Museum, Juneau.

April 9, 2010 - Lecture by Richard Ross at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art, 7:00 p.m., Anchorage.

April 10, 2010 - Lecture by Richard Ross at the University of Alaska, Fairbanks, 7:00 p.m., Fairbanks.

May 7, 2010 - Exhibition opens, Alaska State Museum, Juneau.

November 2010 - Exhibition travels to museums and galleries throughout Alaska.

AWARDS

There will be a \$300.00 Juror's Choice Award and two \$150.00 Awards of Recognition. The awards are sponsored by The Friends of the Alaska State Museum. The juror will also select a number of photographs for Honorable Mention.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The competition is open to any resident of the State of Alaska.
2. Only photographs not shown in previous statewide juried competitions are eligible.
3. Any work that makes use of photographic processes is eligible.
4. All work must be original work and completed within the last three years.
5. Entries may be submitted only by the artist.

CONDITIONS AND SALES

1. Entries are submitted with the understanding that all accepted works may remain in the exhibition through November 2011. Oversize or fragile pieces may not be included in the traveling exhibition, and may be returned following the exhibit in Juneau.
2. Entries will be handled with the greatest possible care. The Museum carries insurance against loss or damage on the premises and in transit for the traveling exhibit. The Museum cannot assume responsibility for normal wear and tear or faulty materials or workmanship.
3. The Museum retains the right to photograph and reproduce works selected for the exhibition for the purposes of documentation, publication, and education, including low-resolution display on the Museum's web site.
4. The Museum will provide a price list of exhibited photographs. Sale of photographs will be negotiated between the photographer and the purchaser.

TRANSPORTATION

2. All mailed entries must be properly packaged in a reusable container. Framed entries will not be accepted.
3. All entries, except those purchased, will be returned to the artist postage-paid by the museum. Entries accepted for the statewide traveling exhibit will be returned following the tour. Unaccepted entries will be returned by mail, or may be picked up in Juneau.
4. Undeliverable entries returned to the Alaska State Museum or hand delivered entries that have not been picked up within one year of the exhibit's closure will be dealt with of at the discretion of the Alaska State Museum.

ENTRIES

1. Each person may enter up to four photographic works.
2. All entries must be mounted or matted on mat board or suitable support. Entries must not be framed. All accepted entries will be framed for exhibition by the Museum. The Museum may re-mat works for exhibition, but all works will be returned with their original mats.
3. Each entry must have an **Identification Label** attached to the back.
4. The **Entry Form** and **Notification Card** must be filled out and submitted with entries.
5. Submit a **\$20 check or money order**, payable to the Alaska State Museum, for shipping and handling. All fees are non-refundable.

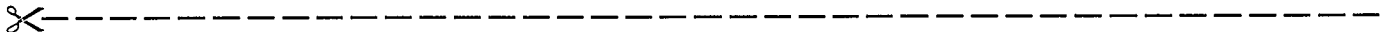

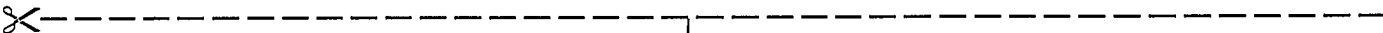

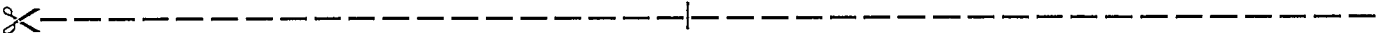
