### Note from the Superintendent

June has been an extremely busy month. Between closing out the fiscal year, admissions, annual evaluations, and preparing for the next fiscal year, my workload was just as heavy as it had been throughout the school year. Without students and teachers on campus, I expected my workday to more closely align to my 7.5-hour minimum work day, but maybe that will come in July. As we reached milestones and deadlines during this last week of June, I am grateful to the dedicated year-round Mt. Edgecumbe staff and the DEED financial, procurement, and federal grants management teams for the grace, support, guidance, and perseverance.

#### Admissions Update (as of 6/27/23)

Target class sizes and openings are general guidelines based on a full capacity dorm and typical schedule. Numbers may be adjusted based on applicants, dorm availability, and class numbers. Seniors are only accepted if transcripts align with graduation requirements.

- Returning students: 250, including 20 day students
- Not returning: 8 officially notified the office they will not return
- Capacity: female dorm beds: 242, male dorm beds: 164

Capacity- 406 Beds (plus 25 day students from Sitka) - 12 beds kept open for illness mitigation

#### Staffing Updates

Over the last few years, MEHS has had unusually high turnover rates among the staff. Some of that is due to retirement, while the other major contributing factor is the difficulty in finding affordable housing in Sitka. We are hopeful to maintain a full staff this school year in almost every department. *Contract staff (dorm, food service, health clinic, custodial) are not included in these numbers*.

- 1. New Certificated Staff
  - 1. 6.5 new teachers (including 1 administrator), plus 1 Long-term Sub (Aug-Dec)
  - 2. 5.5 new classroom teachers of 26.5 classroom teachers = 20.8% turnover
  - 3. 6.5 certificated of 34.5 certificated = 18.8% turnover
- 2. New Office Staff: 2 year-round staff, plus 1 moving from front office to business office
  - 1. 2 new office of 7 office/IT = 28.6% turnover
- 3. Maintenance Staff: 2 of 4 staff resigned between March-July 2023, with one temporary hire
- 4. Current vacancies: 1 Teacher (Art) and 1 Maintenance
