### ♦ ISSUE

The assessment team has prepared a presentation on the 2023-2024 administration of the Alaska System for Academic Readiness (AK STAR) Assessment Results.

## ♦ BACKGROUND

- Each year the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that states administer a summative assessment in English language arts and mathematics to students in grades three through nine annually.
- In 2022 DEED adopted the innovative assessment Alaska System for Academic Readiness (AK STAR). This first year of the assessment did not include the growth component.
- After the spring 2023 administration, the cut scores were adjusted. These new cut scores were applied to the spring 2023 and 2024 results.
- In the spring of 2024, the second administration of the combined assessment was given to students.
